### The Large Family

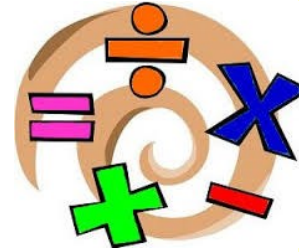
