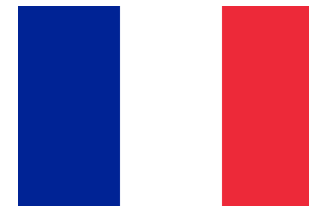

Theme
