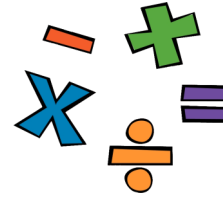

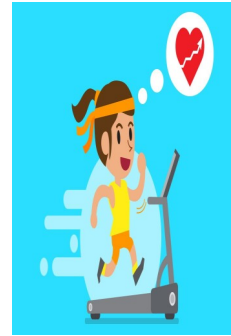

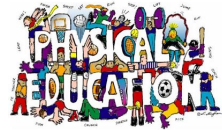
We are astronauts

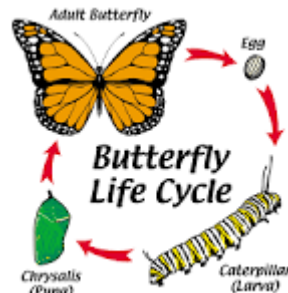
