We will be looking at Horrid Henry stories and tasks will include re-writing endings, character descriptions, letter writing, compiling diary extracts and play scripts.




## Maths

## Theme

### Puppets

In this theme we will be looking at the history of puppets and the different types that exist. We open up with a visitor coming to the school to perform a Punch and Judy puppet show. We will then look at how puppets are made and the children will be given the opportunity to make their own; and they will then perform with accompanying sound effects in a show to a reception class.

### The British Isles

The children will continue to practise map reading skills and develop their understanding of human and physical geography. They will learn about land use and practise the basics of cartography (map making). Research will be undertaken to develop their knowledge of countries in the British Isles and they will also study and draw butterflies indigenous to the local area.
