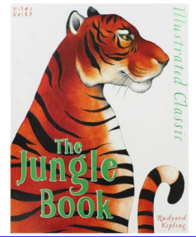

**The Jungle Book by Rudyard Kiping**

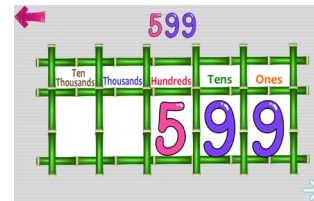
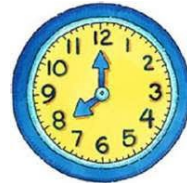
**The Tyger by William Blake**

**Animals Including Humans**

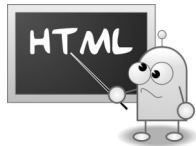
