

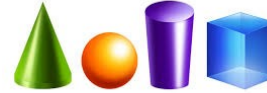
English

P.E. Athletics

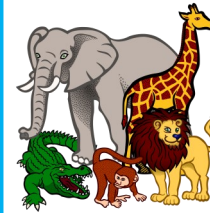
In this unit we explore a number of athletic activities and develop our understanding of rules and techniques associated with them.

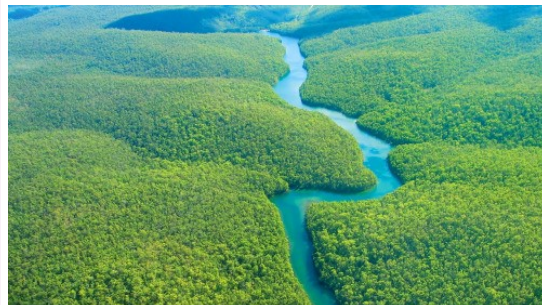
